Imprints Cares Great Expectations, Forsyth Family Voices Award

Winston-Salem, NC, June 15, 2016. Imprints Cares was awarded a \$5K grant as one of the initial, lead agencies for Forsyth Family Voices – an ongoing family engagement initiative of Great Expectations. Imprints Cares will share our “expertise to develop a common tool that will be used to capture the voices of families with young children in Forsyth County to inform program planning, service delivery, and the strategic direction of Great Expectations.” This encompasses the following—

- Contribute to conversations in scheduled Forsyth Family Voices meetings (June)
- Participate in training around facilitated surveys and focus groups with families (June)
- Conduct facilitated surveys with at least twenty-five (25) families (Jul-Aug)
- Run focus groups with at least ten (10) families being served (Jul-Aug)
- Post-survey meeting with other agencies and participating families (Sep)
- Train at least one organization in Forsyth County on new family engagement process by Dec 31, 2016
